The Wheatlands Homeowners are a part of Aurora's Area 16. Our Community Policing Officer is Lemanski who was not present at the meeting. Officer Townsend suggested we log on to "Mypd App" to communicate with Officer Lemanski on any community matters. Good news report – Aurora's burglary is down 80% over a 2yr period. 90% of the burglaries are from unlocked car doors with valuables in view. The officers suggest we keep cars locked, valuables removed and garages closed. Advance warning was also given on the city's enforcement of cell phone use while driving. Hand held Cell phones can not be used while driving. Also talking on a cell phone (handheld or hands free) is not allowed in school zones.
